Responsibilities include pre-trip route planning, packing all food and equipment, completing detailed trip itineraries, managing the safety of all campers while on trip, teaching paddling and camp craft skills, and participating in in-camp programming. Trip Leaders also serve as camp counsellors for their group in camp and on trip.

Must be at least 20 years of age
